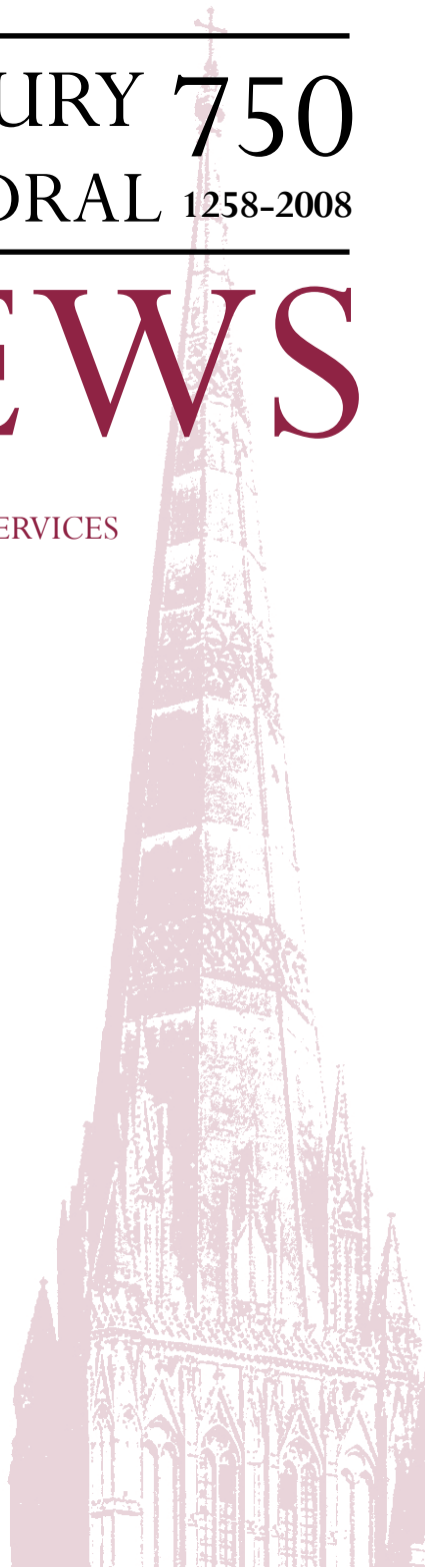

NEW CHORISTERS FOR CATHEDRAL CHOIR

Freddie Foster (8 years) from Salisbury was admitted as a chorister into the Cathedral Choir in a special ceremony during Evensong earlier this month. Freddie began as a probationer chorister just last September but has learnt exceptionally quickly and been made up as a full chorister early.

Following the recent voice trials, choral scholarships have been offered to seven boys and four girls to join the Cathedral Choir including twins Tuomas and Anna Laakkonen.
