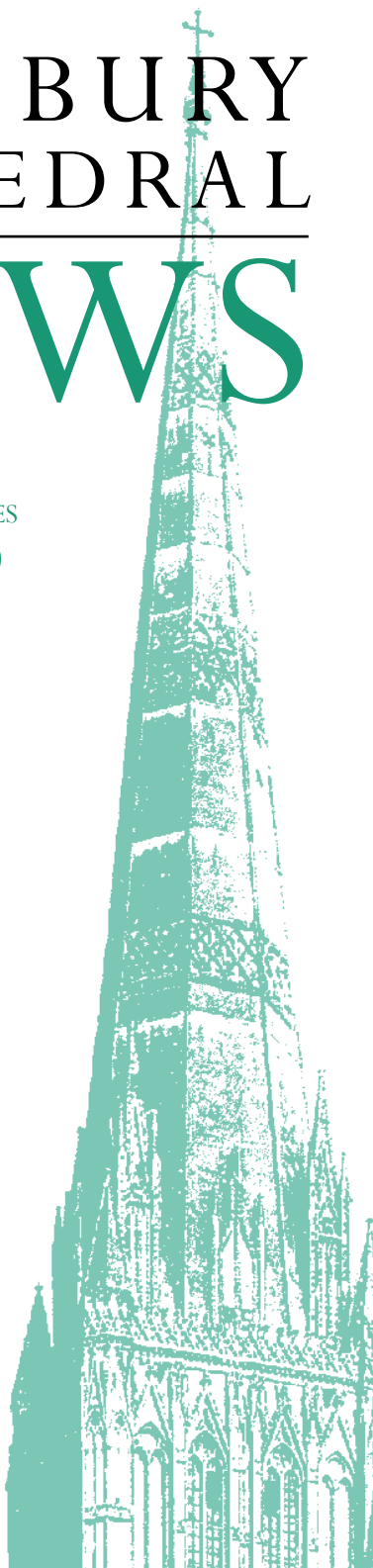

Yakye Axa and Sawhoyamaxa, Indigenous Peoples, Paraguay Indigenous peoples are living in temporary homes beside a busy highway because the land they have inhabited for generations is now in the hands of private owners. Access to clean water, food and medicines is severely limited.

Since 2006, 22 members of the Sawhoyamaxa community have died from preventable causes. In rulings delivered in 2005 and 2006 the Inter-American Court of Human Rights stated it would be legitimate to put the communities' right to land as indigenous peoples above the private interests at stake, and set a deadline of 13 July 2008 for the return of traditional lands to the Yakye Axa and of 19 May 2009 for the Sawhoyamaxa. The Paraguayan authorities have failed to comply.

In June 2009, a Paraguayan congressional committee voted against the return of indigenous lands to Yakye Axa community. Although this decision is not binding, it strikes a severe blow at the attempts of this community to get their lands back.

APPEAL: Remind the authorities that compliance with the rulings of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights is a legal obligation and the traditional lands of the Yakye Axa and Sawhoyamaxa communities must be returned to them.
