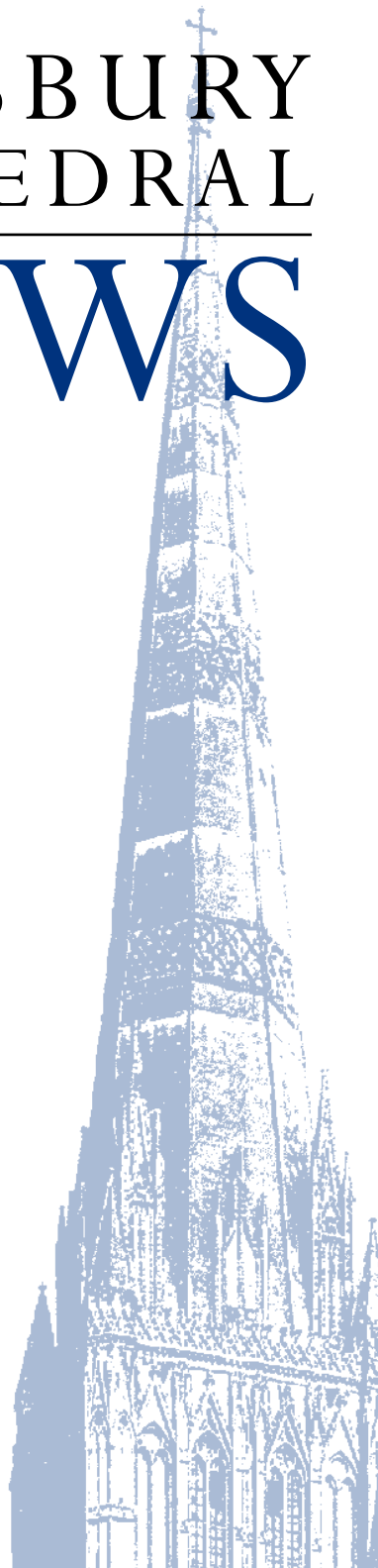

Daniel Cook, Assistant Director of Music at the Cathedral and a hugely talented organist, gives the second performance in this year's recital series on Wednesday May 23 at 7.30pm performing music by Bach, Mendelssohn, Pott, Reger, Rogg and Vierne.

"For my recital this year I have chosen a programme which falls into two distinct sections, both beginning with a Toccata. The first section consists of entirely German works while the second features music from England and France. My aim is to showcase the cathedral's famous Father Willis organ by performing a mixed programme of music from different centuries and countries. This has also provided me with the perfect opportunity to mark three anniversaries which fall this year: the deaths of Mendelssohn and Vierne, and the birth of Francis Pott.

David Halls, Director of Music, said "Daniel's programme contains a wonderfully varied mixture of quality music, all of which will show off both player and instrument. This organ recital will be a real high point of the 2007 series."
