

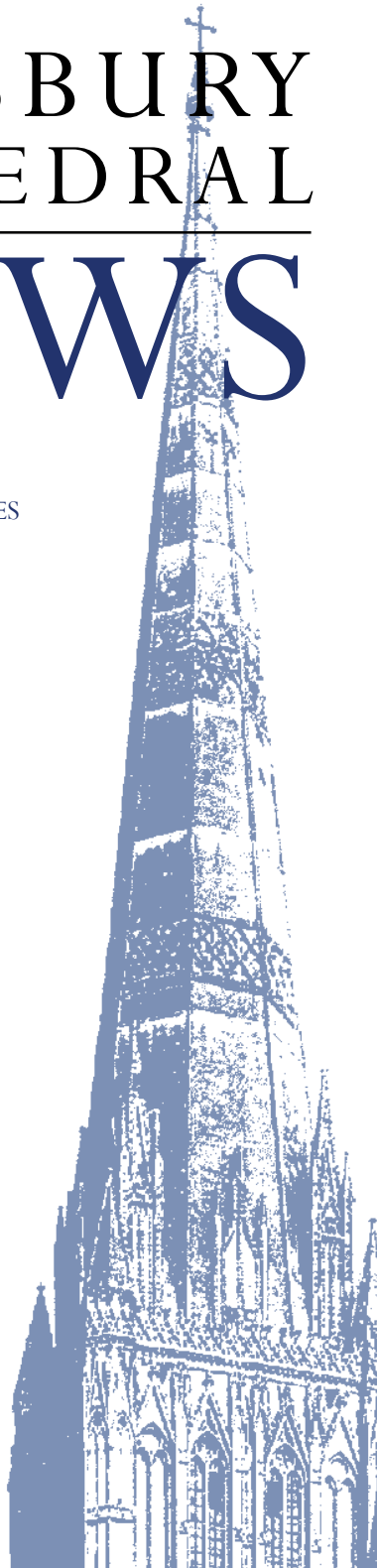

**Film-maker jailed, China** - On 28 December, Tibetan film-maker Dhondup Wangchen was sentenced to six years' imprisonment for a documentary shot before the Beijing Olympics 2008. The film, *Leaving Fear Behind*, features interviews with Tibetans voicing scepticism about the Chinese government's promises for greater freedom in the run up to the games. On 26 March 2008, Dhondup Wangchen was detained in Quinhai province. During weeks of interrogation he was beaten and deprived of food and sleep. On 28 December, Dhondup Wangchen was tried in secret and found guilty of 'subversion' and sentenced. In July 2009, the authorities forced his lawyers to stop representing him.

**North Porch Pilot** - Following the summer 2009 trialling of visitor entry via the North Porch, the subsequent report was viewed by Chapter. It laid out the advantages and difficulties that the alternative entrance had brought with it, summarised the opinions of those who had been closely involved with the trial (including volunteers and staff) and provided a selection of options for future action. After careful review Chapter opted that it would not carry forward the concept of visitor entry via the North Porch. It noted that this would have implications for the long-term planning of visitor welcome. Huge thanks are due to those who contributed their efforts and opinions during the two-month period.
