

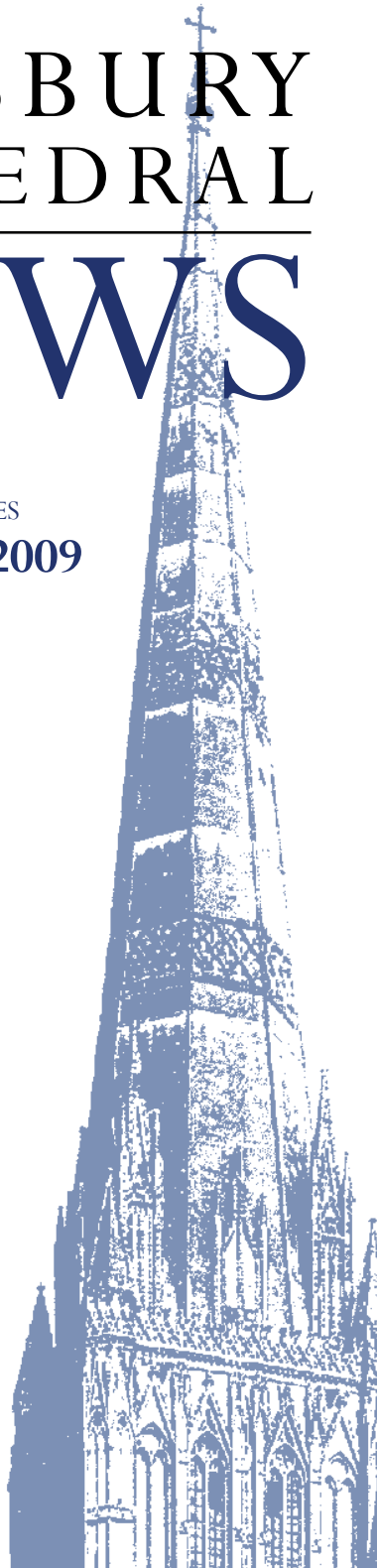

**Detained academic says he was tortured, Israel**

Dr Ghassan Khaled, a university lecturer in Nablus, West Bank, has been detained by the Israeli army since 3 April 2008. He is one of several hundred Palestinians held in administrative detention, without charge or trial.

He was first detained between 16 January and 19 March 2008. He said in court that he was subjected to torture and other ill-treatment by General Security Service Officers. While in detention he suffered an internal haemorrhage.

On 6 March 2008, Dr Khaled was charged with 'performing services for an unauthorised organisation'. At a military court hearing on 12 March, the judge released him on bail, indicating the charges were unsubstantiated. The army rearrested him on 31 March and placed him under administrative detention, alleging that Dr Khaled was planning a military operation.

On 5 April, a military judge ordered his release. The army appealed and on 26 April his administrative detention was reinstated.

APPEAL Please write (address below) and call for Dr Ghassan Khaled to be released or promptly charged with a recognisably criminal offence and tried in proceedings that meet international standards. His reported torture and other ill-treatment should be independently and impartially investigated and those responsible brought to justice.
