

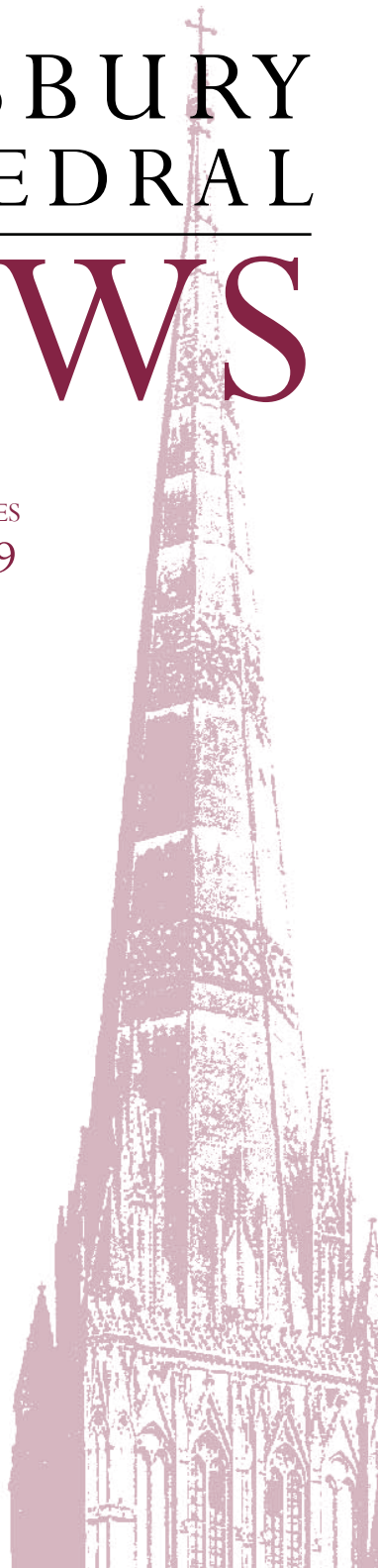

**'ANGEL HEADS'  
INSTALLATION**

**January to 9 February  
2009**

View the work of Britain's greatest contemporary sculptor, Emily Young, whose installation has brought seven and a half newly sculpted Angel Heads to the Cathedral as the final spectacular art installation celebrating our

iconic building's 750<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The heads, one for each century of the Cathedral's history, are installed around the font, in the Trinity Chapel and in the Cloister Garth. Up to one metre square and weighing almost a tonne, they are sculpted from the same Purbeck stone as the Cathedral.
